Lynn Philip Hodgson, a retired business executive who has specialized in exploring the history of the WW2 paramilitary training installation on the Oshawa/Whitby border unofficially known as Camp X. This joint British/Canadian facility had a very major and fascinating role in training spies etc. for the Allied war effort. Lynn has spoken to over 100,000 students and many organizations enlightening them to their rich historical heritage in southern Ontario. He also has taken on many related roles, such as volunteering at the Camp-X Museum in Oshawa and serving as Chair of the Scugog Shores Historical Museum. Lynn now resides in Burlington with his wife Marlene to be close to his children and grandchildren. His presentation

focuses on Camp-X and its very important role - there's even a James Bond connection!
